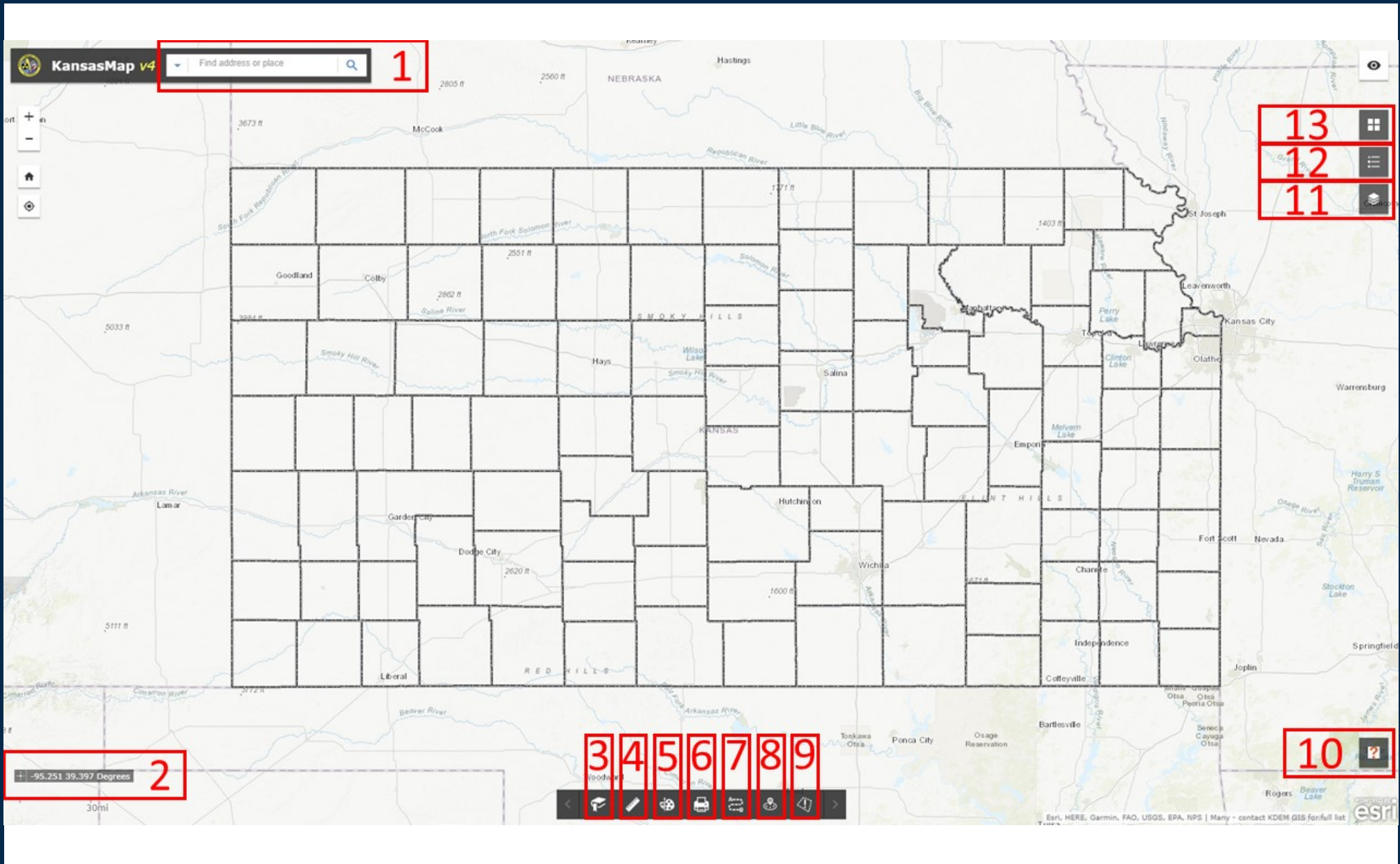


Kansas Map Help Documentation

Geographic Information Systems



1. Find/Search Bar.

This widget allows the user to search for locations. This includes counties, cities, addresses, place names (ex. Grocery Stores, Restaurants, etc.)

2. Coordinate Locator

This displays the current Lat/Long coordinates of your mouse pointer.

3. Bookmarks

Allows user to temporarily save location bookmarks for easier navigation to and from points of interest.

4. Measure

Allows users to measure distances and calculate areas.

5. Draw

The draw widget allows users to temporarily place/draw text, points, lines and polygons on the map until the session is ended, or the objects are deleted.

6. Print

The print widget allows users to export print quality maps from the online platform. Allowing you to choose the title, author, layout type, etc.

7. Directions

The directions widget allows users to get turn by turn directions from one place to another and allows users to export/print those directions.

8. Near Me

The Near-Me widget allows users to analyze what features exist within a user defined search distance.

To use the widget, click on it to open. Define your search distance, and either type in a location name, or place a point, to initiate the search. This will return you all features, their information and distance, within the defined range, grouped by layer type.



9. Situational Awareness

The Situation Awareness widget allows you to specify a location on the map and analyze information from different feature layers within the specified area.

How to:

1. Open the widget by clicking on its icon
2. Define an incident location in one of two ways...
 - Click an existing feature to show its popup then click the ellipsis button to see the list of feature actions and choose Set Location.
 - Use the drawing tools on the widget's Incident tab to create a new location to analyze.
3. Click the individual Layer tabs to view the analyzed information for specified layers. You can scroll the widget panel horizontally to view additional results.
4. Export your results if needed.

The Help widget provides another location for this document within the map interface.

The Help widget is also how to request an account or change your current password.

11. Layer List

The Layer List widget lists of all the layers available in the map for viewing/analysis.

12. Legend

The Legend is a reference for the symbology observed in the map.

13. Basemap Gallery

The Basemap Gallery widget allows you to switch between different ESRI online basemaps.
